WINDOWS 95 INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

To install while running under Windows 95, follow these steps:

- (1) Insert the Redneck Rampage Suckin' Grits on Route 66 CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive.
- (2) If you have Autoplay enabled, then CD-ROM will spin for a moment and the setup program will start automatically.
- (3) If you do not have Autoplay enabled, double-click on "My Computer", open the CD-ROM and double-click the Setup icon.
- (4) The setup program will now try to find an installed version of Redneck Rampage. If Setup cannot find an installed version of Redneck Rampage, you will be prompted to BROWSE through the directories to locate the Redneck Rampage install directory. Once this directory is selected, click "Next."
- (5) A window will pop up with a list of settings for the setup. These settings include the group for the shortcut, location of Redneck Rampage, and the amount of disk space required for the installation. If these settings are acceptable, click "Next."
- (6) The Route 66 files will then be copied to your computer system. When this is complete, click the "Finish" button and then you are ready to play the new episode.

To run Route 66 simply run the shortcut that the setup program installed. Once Redneck Rampage starts, select the Route 66 Episode.

DOS INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

To install while running under DOS, follow these steps:

- (1) Place the Route 66 CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive.
- (2) From the DOS command prompt, type "**D:**" and press Enter, assuming "**D**" is the drive letter of your CD-ROM drive. Next type 'Install' and press Enter.
- (3) After a few seconds the DOS based Route 66 installation program will begin running. The program will prompt you to enter the location in which you have Redneck Rampage installed. The default path is c:\Interplay\Redneck. Enter the full path in the box provided and hit Enter.

(4) The install program will verify that this is the correct location and then begin copying files. When the copy is complete, press Enter and then you are ready to play the new episode.

To run Route 66 from the DOS command prompt (or a DOS window in Windows 95), change into the directory where you have Redneck Rampage installed. From this directory, run the Route 66 executable by typing "ROUTE66.EXE" and then pressing Enter.

UNINSTALLING ROUTE 66

If for some reason you wish to uninstall the Suckin' Grits On Route 66 episode, follow these simple steps:

For DOS: Change directories into the Redneck Rampage directory. Type 'uninst66' and hit enter. All the files associated with the Route 66 episode will be removed from your computer.

For Windows 95: To uninstall, go to Control Panel -> Add/Remove Programs, select "Route 66" and click on the Add/Remove button. The uninstaller only removes the files installed by the installer. Any files created after the install (e.g., config files, save games, etc.) must be removed by hand.

PLAYING MULTIPLAYER ROUTE 66

Launching a multiplayer game of any Route 66 map is very similar to the way the regular Redneck Rampage maps are launched for multiplayer.

Follow these simple steps:

(1) From the START menu shortcut: There is a Route 66 Multiplayer shortcut accessible from your START menu. This shortcut can be found under START -> INTERPLAY PRODUCTIONS - > Route 66-Multiplayer

(2) Directly from the Redneck Install Directory: From a DOS window or command prompt, change directories into the directory where you have Redneck Rampage installed. From this directory, run the Route 66 Multiplayer executable by typing ROUTE66M.EXE and then pressing ENTER.

(3) A few seconds after you run the shortcut or the ROUTE66M.EXE executable, the SETUP program for Redneck Rampage will launch. From the setup program, choose the type of multiplayer connection you wish to use, then select the menu option 'Select User Level'. From the list of maps that appear, select the Route 66 map you wish to play. Then proceed to start the multiplayer game as normal. Enjoy!

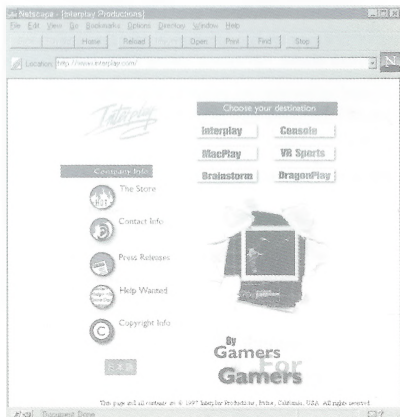
